This tasty piece of news slipped by us in December, but now we're in the middle of the January freeze, we think we're going to savor it even more: [Hollywood Beach Suites, Hostel + Hotel](#) in Florida has a brand new Mexican cantina, [Taco Beach Shack](#). We love all three of those things, so how can it go wrong?

Located on A1A just off Hollywood Boulevard, the huge outdoor space has a wraparound bar, sofas, ping-pong tables, large plasma screens--and soon it will also have a swimming pool.



Then, of course, there are the tacos. Executive chef Stuart Snowwhite (formerly of Westin Hotels in Houston) swears that his dishes come straight from Mexico, although there are a few original dishes on the menu, too.

Being by the beach means you'll want to go for the signature seafood items, such as the Baja-style fish tacos (\$10.99) but there are plenty of other options as well, including burritos, nachos, and Huevos rancheros from the breakfast menu.

**Taco Beach Shack** is open seven days a week from 8 a.m to 10 p.m. Sunday through Thursday and until 2 a.m. on Friday and Saturday. If you overdose on quesadillas and margaritas, you can always consider staying over--a bunk in a shared room at the Hollywood Beach Hostel is on special this weekend for just **\$18.75 a night**.

The name of that rate? 'Single and Ready to Mingle.'
